#### Chai Cancer Care

Chai Cancer Care is the Jewish Community's dedicated cancer support organisation operating from 11 centres across the UK. We are currently supporting over 4,000 cancer patients and their loved ones. Our clients are aged between 3-99. Clients can also benefit from Chai's expertise and care through the Home Support Service and via telephone and Zoom. We do not charge for any of our services and receive no statutory funding and rely on the generous support of the community.



#### **Jewish Care**

Jewish Care, the largest health and social care organisation serving the Jewish community in London and the South East, touches the lives of 12,000 people each week. Jami, part of Jewish Care, provides vital mental health support services to those 11 years-old upwards, whose mental illness and distress make everyday life a struggle. 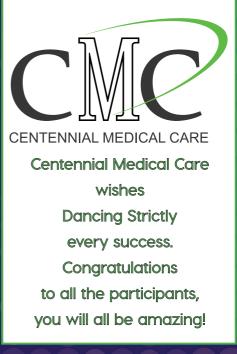

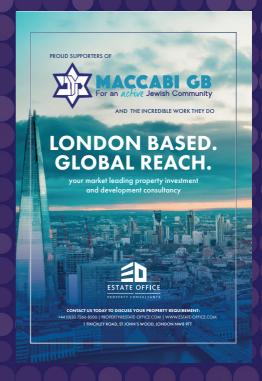
